What is QMMML?

QMMML is an online **group learning seminar** offered by the Mixed Methods Program at the University of Michigan that meets twice monthly from September-May. It is designed for **scholars conducting mixed methods and qualitative research**. **Facilitated by Mixed Methods Program faculty**, it offers expert panel review and peer feedback, and support the use of mixed methods locally and by scholars around the world.



QMMML Schedule

Session 1: "Methods"

1st Tuesday each month, 11am-12:00pm ET

Mixed Methods Program faculty and invited speakers present seminars on a range of topics relevant to qualitative and mixed methods research.

Session 2: "Work-in-Progress"

3rd Friday each month, 11am-12:00pm ET

This session provides outside participants (faculty or students) the opportunity to present their research projects at any stage to the group to solicit expert and peer feedback for utilizing mixed methods concepts/designs.



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
